Has it been awhile since your unit's bylaws have been updated? If so, chances are you have a **standard set of bylaws** that were manually filled out on paper. When updating a standard set of bylaws, care needs to be taken to follow the instructions at the beginning of the document so when the bylaws are completed the entire document is consistent in its details.

Registering for an e-Bylaws username and password gives you access to a series of menus that automates the updating process thus ensuring the bylaws remain consistent. And while the bylaws still need to be printed out, approved by the board and submitted thru channels, you can be confident that e-Bylaws has the details worked out. **Get Started**
