LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT


Hello!

Business with the CA Attorney General

It is very important to do a 'health check' for your unit with the CA AG. If your unit has missed submitting paperwork to the CA AG office, then your unit will be put on a delinquent or suspended list. Once suspended you cannot operate until you submit all the missing paperwork.



The treasurer should check your unit's status following these steps:

1. Go to this website: <http://rct.doj.ca.gov/Verification/Web/Search.aspx?facility=Y>

2. On this screen (link to attached file), type FEIN, City and state (CA) to see the record.

3. If you see 'current' in the Registration Status column, then your unit's paperwork with AG office is up to date. You can click on your PTA name to see more details.

4. If you see any other status (delinquent, expired, etc) in the Registration Status column, then click on your PTA name to see the details of missing paperwork. To clear the status you will need to submit the missing paperwork immediately.
